March 13, 2021 Trail Maintenance Report

Three volunteers worked Saturday morning March 13th to perform trail maintenance activities on the Perdido River Hiking Trail. The volunteer activity was mostly focused on chainsaw work needed on the trail south of Gravel Landing from hurricane damage a few months ago. Approximately 20 trees that were blocking the trail were removed. Chainsaw work is not a trail maintenance activity that is usually performed and is only needed after bad storms. Typical trail maintenance involves removing small branches and cutting weeds starting to grow. Even with only three people, the club had a great time and a significant investment to the trail was made on this Saturday. See the before/after photos below!
